

Racial Diversity

Note:

This map illustrates the racial diversity of neighborhoods in the San Francisco Bay Area. While the rural/ suburban areas in the region have largely white populations, many urban/ densely populated areas in the region are racially diverse, with two or more ethnicities living in relatively non-segregated neighborhoods.
