

 The American Petroleum Institute collects data on gasoline taxes quarterly from all 50 states. Combined taxes include local, state and federal taxes. Nationwide, the national average tax on gasoline of 49.5 cents rose 1.4 cents between January and May 2011. The federal tax on gasoline is 18.4 cents.
